## **Mississippi Export Railroad Emphasizes Safety**

*Moss Point, MS – May 5, 2010* - Mississippi Export Railroad (MSE) was recently awarded its fifth consecutive Jake Award for excellence in safety. “Safe work execution involves each employee following procedure, always concentrating, and keeping a clear head”, said President D. Gregory Luce. “We are very proud of this accomplishment and the employees of Mississippi Export Railroad for their efforts in achieving this award.”

The Jake Award is presented annually to Class III railroads that have a frequency-severity index (FSI) rating of zero as measured by the American Short Line and Regional Railroad Association. The Mississippi Export Railroad has been awarded the Jake Award with Distinction 3 of the past 5 years, and the Jake Award 2 of the past 5 years. The MSE owns 42 miles of mainline track interchanging with the CN (Evanston, MS), and the CSX (Pascagoula, MS). Through a haulage agreement with the CN the Mississippi Export easily connects to the NS (Hattiesburg, MS and Mobile, AL) and the KCS (Jackson, MS). Along with line-haul movements, the MSE offers services in railcar maintenance, bulk transloading, warehousing, and railcar storage.
